

## Ensure your students meet the new UK Border Agency Tier 4 language requirements

On 3 March 2010 new requirements came into effect for students coming to the UK to study under Tier 4 of the UK Border Agency Points Based System. One of these requirements is that students must be competent in English language at a minimum of CEFR level B1.

EDI offers a range of English language qualifications, some of which have already been approved by the UK Border Agency as meeting the English language requirements for Tier 1 and Tier 2 of the Points Based System. Below are our language qualifications that are aligned to CEFR B1 and which will help you to ensure that your students meet the new Tier 4 language requirements.
