The Level 3 Award in English for Accounting helps students to develop and demonstrate their English language skills in the context of Book-keeping and Accounting. The qualification is intended for non-native English speakers working or intending to work in an accounts related function where they have to communicate using Book-keeping and Accounting vocabulary and terminology in English at CEF B2 (Vantage) level. English for Accounting is also suitable for candidates who are pursuing or have already passed LCCI IQ financial qualifications and wish to demonstrate their understanding and abilities to use Book-keeping and Accounting vocabulary and terminology in English.

This qualification can be taken in its own right or as a part of the following new Diplomas:

- Level 3 Specialised Diploma in Accounting and Finance
- Level 3 Specialised Diploma in Managerial Accounting
- Level 3 Specialised Diploma in Cost Accounting
- Level 3 Specialised Diploma in Business Management and Accounting
